Congratulations on winning a "NATIONAL FIRST PRIZE" in your class at the recent AACA National Meet. Your vehicle is now considered a "JUNIOR" First Prize Winner.

Your vehicle advances to "SENIOR" status and will remain so until a "SENIOR AWARD" is won.

Enclosed you will find a National First Prize Winners Plaque. It is most important that you immediately attach it to a prominent place on the vehicle. Aside from the honor this plaque signifies, judges will be able to instantly recognize your vehicle as a First Junior Award Winner and know you are competing for a "SENIOR AWARD."

AACA Judging Guidelines state that any vehicle competing for a Senior Award, but not having the National First Prize Winners Plaque permanently attached in a prominent place on the vehicle, shall be disqualified from competition.

This plaque shall remain with the vehicle in the event of a change of ownership or if the vehicle undergoes a complete restoration within ten years of the date on the plaque. Anytime thereafter, the plaque may be returned to AACA National Headquarters and the vehicle can once again compete in the "JUNIOR" category.
